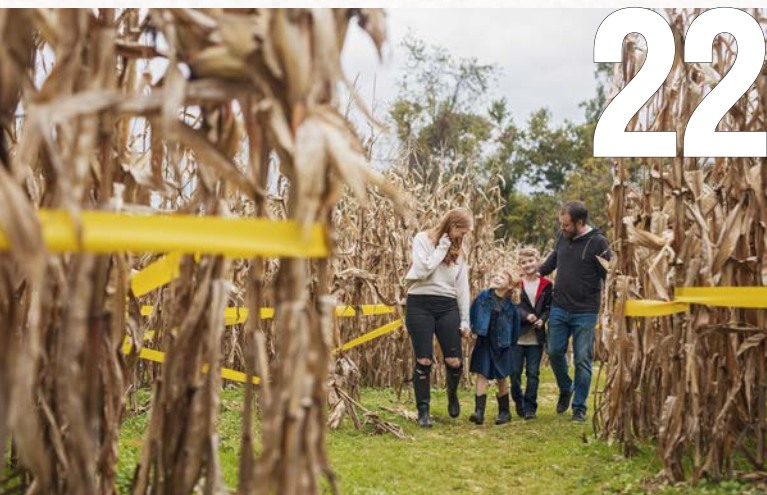

Intro to Putnam

IN THE HEART OF THE METRO VALLEY, PUTNAM COUNTY BLENDS

Small-town charm with a warm welcome.

Putnam County is home to everything from thriving locally owned businesses to advanced manufacturing. You'll find friendly faces; well-maintained public parks; clean, safe communities; and excellent schools.



POPULATION & GROWTH

The 2020 US Census reported Putnam County with a population of 57,440 reflecting an increase of 1,954 from the 2010 US Census. Population density is 166.2 persons per square mile. Putnam County is one of the fastest-growing counties in the state.



TRANSPORTATION

Interstate 64 passes through the center of Putnam County. The four-lane US Route 35 opened in 2009 with final completion 2022 and connects the Crooked Creek interchange at I-64 to the Buffalo Bridge. The Kanawha River also flows through the center of the county and is a major carrier of barge traffic. Railroad service is provided by CSX Transportation and Norfolk & Southern. Airports are located in both Huntington and Charleston.



MAJOR INDUSTRIES

Healthcare & Social Assistance, Retail Trade, and Manufacturing comprise major industries. Because of the close proximity to the state Capitol, many residents are also employed by the government.

TOWNS & CITIES

Bancroft, Buffalo, Eleanor, Hurricane, Poca, Winfield, and Nitro (in both Putnam & Kanawha counties). Unincorporated areas: Fraziers Bottom, Hometown, Liberty, Pliny, Red House, Scott Depot, and Teays Valley. The county seat is Winfield.

Aluminum Cans – Beverage cans of all types.

#1 and #2 Plastics – Common containers such as water bottles, milk jugs, and detergent bottles.

Clean Bi-Metal Food Cans – Steel and tin cans that are rinsed and free of food residue.

The Putnam Career & Technical Center (PCTC) stands as a beacon of career readiness and hands-on learning for students across the county. Offering over 20 career-focused programs, PCTC equips both

secondary and adult learners with the skills, certifications, and experiences needed to thrive in today’s workforce.

The Toyota 4T Academy is an innovative workforce initiative that has grown into a signature opportunity for PCTC students. This work-based learning program focuses on advanced manufacturing. It provides hands-on experience and training alongside mentorship from Toyota employees. Its recent Signing Day marked a milestone in the program’s success, celebrating students’ commitments to industry partners and future careers in technical trades.

Beyond technical skills, students gain real-world experiences and credentials in high-demand areas such as healthcare, manufacturing, public safety, and construction. Fifty-four dual credit classes are now offered across the county’s four high schools and PCTC, helping students get a jumpstart on college or career paths.

In 2025 alone, PCTC students earned over \$240,000 in wages through structured work placements. PCTC’s excellence is recognized statewide. In the most recent WVDE-issued report card, the center met or exceeded 98% of standards. Additionally, Chef Lynette Jones was named WVATCE Teacher of the Year, and CD Caldwell earned the

distinction of WVATCE Administrator of the Year. With a continued emphasis on career readiness, innovation, and student support, PCTC continues to elevate the profile of technical education across West Virginia.

With onsite lab and imaging services, as well as the 2025 relocation of Marshall Toxicology (providing advanced drug testing solutions across southern West Virginia) the campus offers a true one-stop destination for comprehensive care.

Marshall Health Network's pediatrics team in Teays Valley delivers care that grows with families, from well-child visits and immunizations to specialized services like sports medicine and developmental-behavioral pediatrics, which supports children with ADHD, autism and behavioral disorders

"Living and working in Putnam County is truly special," said Susanna Kapourales, M.D., Marshall Health Network pediatrician and assistant professor at the Marshall University Joan C. Edwards School of Medicine. "This community has become home for my family – a place built on trust, connection and heart."

Homes in the area sell quickly—often within a week—reflecting the county's strong housing demand. To meet future needs, the Putnam County Development Authority is partnering with Stonewall Capital to add more than 600 new homes, ensuring that more families can experience all that makes Putnam County a great place to live, work, and thrive.



To help address this demand, the Putnam County Development Authority is partnering with Stonewall Capital on a major residential development that will introduce approximately 600 new homes, primarily single-family residences in Hurricane and Frazier's Bottom. This investment will expand housing options while supporting continued growth and long-term stability throughout the county.

For homebuyers looking for a place that offers top-tier schools, a safe and welcoming environment, and unmatched convenience, Putnam County stands out as a smart and meaningful choice. EMPOWERING CAREER-SEEKERS AND ENRICHING EMPLOYERS



The Kanawha Valley FAME (Federation for Advanced Manufacturing Education) program merges education with hands-on experience to create a dynamic future. This initiative fosters a powerful partnership between eager apprentices and the local businesses seeking their talents.

For career seekers, it's a pathway to a stable future:

At its heart, the Kanawha Valley FAME program opens doors for career seekers aiming for careers in advanced manufacturing and industrial maintenance. Participants engage in a focused, two-year curriculum that seamlessly blends classroom learning with real-world experience. The program offers countless opportunities, including:

Limited Financial Burden: Through its innovative programs, Kanawha Valley FAME provides scholarships and grants that empower apprentices to pursue their education with less financial strain, allowing them to concentrate on their

future. Often, apprentices receive their associate's degree in Advanced Manufacturing Technology tuition and fee-free. You'll attend classes two days a week at BridgeValley Career & Technical Center.

Real World, Paid Experience: Apprentices benefit from practical training through apprenticeships at local manufacturing companies, ensuring they are well-prepared for the job market, equipped with knowledge and industry experience with some of the region's top employers, including Toyota Motor Manufacturing West Virginia, Nucor Steel West Virginia, and Niterra North America. You'll be compensated for the three days a week you work for your employer.

Networking, Opening Doors to Your Future: By building relationships with local manufacturers and industry leaders, apprentices can open doors to their careers. Engaging in a mentorship with an experienced industrial maintenance technician enriches their understanding of the manufacturing

landscape and sets them up for success.

A Brighter Future: The skills acquired through this program pave the way for various opportunities in industrial maintenance, allowing graduates to emerge as highly competitive candidates ready to make their mark. According to the Workforce West Virginia Labor Market Information tool, manufacturing is one of the fastest-growing employment sectors in West Virginia.

A Pathway to Higher Education and Promotion: Several former apprentices have used the FAME program to further their education and gain employment in STEM fields like engineering, and several have become managers. The vertical mobility of a FAME graduate is limitless!

Coloring The County

HOW MURALS ARE ENHANCING PUTNAM'S LANDSCAPE



As you explore Putnam County, a colorful surprise might greet you around the corner: a splash of paint, a bold image, a tribute to history, or a whimsical creature peeking out from a wall. Public murals are quietly reshaping how people see and feel about our vibrant community, and one artist at the heart of it all is JP Owens.

Owens, a Putnam County native, local artist, and President of the Putnam Area Community Enrichment (PACE) Foundation, is behind many of the area's best-known murals. But he's also a champion for all public art, no matter the creator.

"It enhances whatever space it's in," Owens says. "Even a dull wall becomes vibrant, energetic, and welcoming. It's not just beautification — it's communication. Murals can honor history, signal growth, or simply get people talking."

In Hurricane, Owens painted a steam engine mural on the side of Belknap Pizza, and just down Main Street, a wizard-themed piece graces another building. Inside Area 34, his mountain biker mural celebrates local trails and the community that supports them.

But he's not alone in painting Putnam's picture. Hurricane's former fire station features a mural by the late Stan Sporny, while the Raymond City Boat Launch displays a decade-old

train mural by Rob Cleland. The Meeks Mountain Trails in particular has become a creative haven. Murals there include a cryptid series by Liz Pavlovic, surreal animals by Blake Wheeler, and a jumping biker silhouette by Melinda Owens. There's even one painted entirely by local students.

"Eddie Spaghetti came down from Morgantown and knocked out a full mural in less than 48 hours — camping on the trail the whole time," Owens laughs.

Other murals have been in place for decades, like the Cheshire Cat piece in Poca or the historical farm scene across from Hurricane City Hall. But old or new, each one contributes to a growing sense of place and pride.

It's this spirit that fuels Owens' work with the PACE Foundation. As for what's next? Owens has a few ideas brewing, especially for local spots like Gritt's Farm — but he's always open to community suggestions. "Public art isn't just for artists," he adds. "It's about everyone who lives here. If someone has an idea or something they'd like to see in the county, I'd love to hear it."

So the next time you're exploring Putnam County, keep your eyes open. You might just find a new mural — and a fresh way to see beauty in your community.

A Trail FOR EVERY TREKKER



If you're looking to lace up your hiking boots, grab your bike helmet, or just take a leisurely walk with the family, there's a trail for you. With an impressive variety of paths that stretch from stroller-friendly strolls to rugged mountain climbs, the county offers outdoor adventures for all ages, skill levels, and interests.

The largest of Putnam's trail systems is Meeks Mountain Trails, a network of more than 35 miles of purpose-built paths winding through the hills of Hurricane. Designed for mountain bikers, runners, and hikers alike, these trails are a shining example of community-driven outdoor recreation. Whether you're looking for a quiet morning walk or a heart-pumping ride, Meeks Mountain has a route to match your pace.

Over in Eleanor, the Eleanor Park Trails offer a more classic trail experience. Popular with mountain bikers and hikers, this established network provides a scenic mix of forested paths and challenging climbs. It's a go-to spot for locals looking to squeeze in a quick loop or spend a full afternoon exploring the woods.

For a more relaxed outing, Valley Park in Hurricane features wide, gravel walking paths ideal for families, strollers, and anyone seeking a gentle walk. One of the most beloved attractions here is the Bear Wood Fairy Trail, a whimsical path filled with tiny fairy doors and woodland charm—sure to delight young hikers and the young-at-heart. Don't miss the butterfly mural at the trailhead, or the Almost Heaven swing by the large pond, two perfect photo spots.

Nature lovers will enjoy the Walter Nature Preserve, a 1-mile loop trail with a half-mile cutoff option, perfect for a short hike with lots to see. This easy-to-moderate trail doubles as an educational experience, with interpretive signs highlighting local plant and tree species. It's an excellent choice for school groups or anyone wanting to learn more about the natural world around them.

Looking for something more challenging? The Mary Ingles Trail in Winfield offers an 11.3-mile out-and-back trek that's as scenic as it is demanding. Named after the legendary frontier woman who famously escaped captivity and journeyed hundreds of miles home, this trail offers a taste of wild, untamed West Virginia beauty—and a serious workout to match.

Over in Buffalo, the Toyota Biodiversity Trail sits quietly beside the Toyota Manufacturing Plant, open to the public for those who want to enjoy a peaceful walk. This flat trail is perfect for nature observation, with native plants and wildlife offering a relaxing, educational experience.

And for the truly adventurous, the Red Rock Trail is a must. This difficult, scramble-worthy path climbs to a unique overlook of the Kanawha River. It's not for the faint of heart, but the payoff is worth the effort.

From casual strolls to steep climbs, Putnam County's trail offerings are as diverse as the people who use them. If you're a seasoned hiker, weekend wanderer, or just getting started, there's a path here waiting for you. So come explore—one step at a time.

MEEKS MOUNTAIN *Trails*

A COMMUNITY FUELED GEM AT THE HEART OF THE VALLEY

Just a mile from I-64 in Hurricane, the Meeks Mountain Trail System winds through more than 35 miles of wooded hills and rock formations—offering a mix of hiking, running, and mountain biking opportunities. But beyond the adventure, these trails tell a story of community spirit and shared purpose.

Brandon Doerner, president of the Meeks Mountain Trail Alliance, first envisioned the trail system after noticing the area's active lifestyle. "I saw all the runners, all the active lifestyles, and knew that the demand was there," he says.

Designed with "flow" in mind, the trail network welcomes users of all skill levels, from beginners to seasoned adventurers. "It's important we had somebody from the mountain bike design scene lay this thing out; the flow was very important for all users," Doerner adds.

Built entirely by volunteers—more than 500 people who logged over 23,000 hours—the trail system is a powerful symbol of what can happen when a community comes together.

"This has all been developed by volunteers; by a family that was willing to allow us to study and build this thing; a city that supports it; and the companies throughout the community that have gathered around it to help promote it," Doerner says.

Meeks Mountain has become more than a recreation destination. It's now a hub for races, educational hikes, and future plans like an outdoor classroom. Events like the Hurricane 100K draw visitors from across the country. "Our whole mission with the Hurricane 100K race is

to promote what we've done, promote this area for the volunteers, promote our state ultimately," says Doerner.

While the terrain may challenge visitors' expectations of the Teays Valley name, it also showcases the surprising natural beauty and resilience of the region. "You can lay in the valleys all your life, and that's fine. But if you want to get to the top, you've got to work for it," Doerner reflects.

With an average of 300+ daily users—and more than 500 on weekends—the trails are a consistent part of local life. Convenient access points near Teays Valley Road encourage routine visits and community connection. "Just like any business out there, you want to create habitual customers," Doerner says. "The trail system is no different."

For many, it's not just about fitness—it's about forming habits, connecting with nature, and feeling pride in a shared community asset.

"I want folks to understand the beauty of it too," Doerner says. "They're going to get to see diversity out there... and they get the experience of being close to home, yet feeling far away."

Parks and Outdoor Activities

Putnam County is home to some of the most scenic and family-friendly parks in the region. Plan a weekend picnic, find space to get active, or unwind in nature at a perfect spot waiting for you in one of our parks.

From well appointed sports complexes to quiet wooded trails, each park in Putnam County has its own unique personality, and together, they offer something for everyone.

Valley Park – Hurricane, WV

The crown jewel of Putnam County parks, Valley Park in Hurricane is a community hub for recreation and relaxation. Home to Waves of Fun, a seasonal favorite, it also features a large playground, soccer field, tennis courts, a dog park, scenic walking trails, plentiful picnic shelters, and the interactive science center Zoology Zone. It also boasts West Virginia's highest-rated disc golf course. With year-round events, a modern conference center, and space for everything from yoga to weddings, Valley Park truly brings people together.

Hurricane City Park

Located just off Teays Valley Road, this bustling park is a favorite for families and sports enthusiasts. Hurricane City Park includes little league fields, basketball courts, tennis courts, and one of the area's best skate parks. The shaded walking trail loops around the complex, offering a great path for casual strolls or jogs. And for a more strenuous adventure, explore Meeks Mountain Trails where the trailhead is conveniently located at the back of Hurricane City Park.

Hurricane Bridge Park

Tucked beside Hurricane Creek, Hurricane Bridge Park features two sections split by the creek. The Upper Park features an 18-hole disc golf course, pickleball courts, and a baseball/softball complex. The Lower Park houses pickleball courts and a football field.

Mitchell's Grove

Located in the heart of Hometown, this roadside park offers quiet beauty. This peaceful spot has a playground, picnic tables, a pollinator garden, and green space perfect for playing catch or just soaking up the sun.

Eleanor Park

Eleanor might be a small town, but its park packs a punch. With sports fields, an 18-hole disc golf course, hiking/biking trails, and even a town pool, Eleanor Park is buzzing with activity. The well-maintained grounds and family-friendly amenities make it a go-to for summer outings and is home to the annual Putnam County Fair.

Ester & Walter Norman Nature Trail

If you're craving a walk in the woods, the Norman Nature Trail is your destination. Located in the Red House area, this 1-mile looping wooded path offers a quiet escape for walkers, birdwatchers, and anyone needing a little forest therapy. It's not overly long, but it's the perfect spot to reconnect with nature.

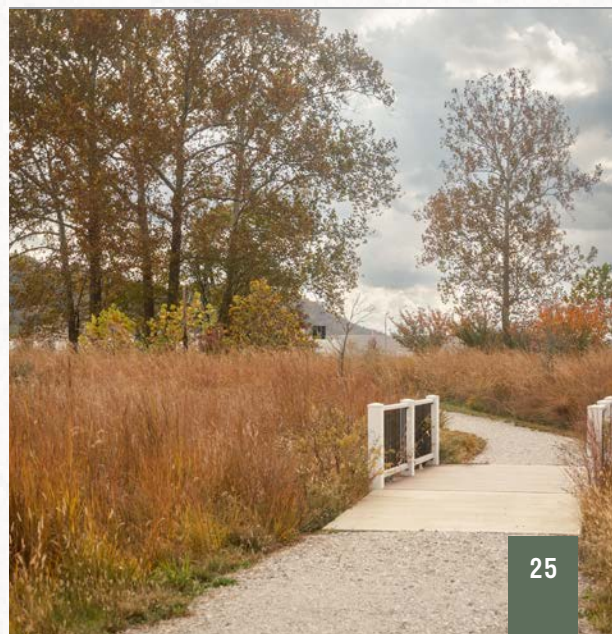

THE MEEKS *Family*



Putnam County has grown and changed over the years because of steady involvement from people who chose to invest locally. The Meeks family has been one of those consistent presences, contributing time, resources, and land to projects that continue to benefit the county.

Across multiple decades, the family has supported community initiatives that focus on long-term value rather than short-term recognition. Their contributions have included significant land donations and financial support for projects intended to be used by the public—efforts that helped expand recreational opportunities and protect open space as the county developed.

One of the more visible results of that involvement is the preservation and use of land for outdoor recreation. By making land available for public projects, the Meeks family helped create spaces where residents can walk, bike, and spend time outdoors. These areas now serve a wide range of people, from families and students to visitors exploring the county.

The family has also supported broader community projects by providing early or foundational backing, allowing local organizations and volunteers to move ideas forward. In many cases, their role has been practical and behind the scenes—helping close funding gaps or making land available when it was needed—rather than seeking attention.

What stands out about the Meeks family's involvement is its consistency. Their contributions have followed a clear pattern: support projects that improve daily life in Putnam County and leave room for future growth. That steady participation has helped reinforce a culture of local investment and shared responsibility.

Today, the results of that approach are part of the county's everyday landscape. Trails, public spaces, and community resources supported by the family's generosity continue to be used and maintained by residents. Their role in Putnam County's story is not defined by a single project, but by an ongoing commitment to helping the community function better and plan ahead.
